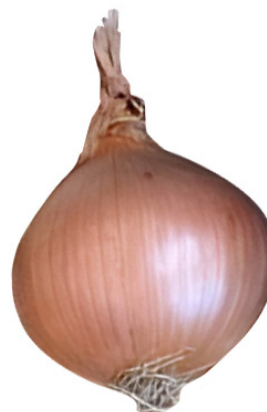


# ONION ON 2527
